- Must be a Canadian Citizen; a Permanent Resident or a Protected Person;
- Must be an Ontario resident;
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by Ryerson University through completion of a detailed budget submission in accordance with OTSS guidelines;
- Must be a third-year full-time student enrolled in the Fashion Communication program in the School of Fashion;
- Must be in clear academic standing with a minimum CGPA of 3.50;
- Must demonstrate in a written statement their past commitment as a volunteer, with strong indication of their humanitarian interests, and their impact on Fashion journalism and publishing.

Decision: The winner will be notified via their Ryerson email.

Presentation: School of Fashion annual Awards Ceremony in November 2018.

Application: Submit this cover page, a written statement, the OTSS student budget form and the FIPPA agreement.
